#### **ABOUT THE COMPANY**

Founded in 2009, Greenwich Glass is a smaller AGI member contractor, yet no less committed to customer service and craftsmanship. President Albert A. (Burt) Dameika, III, leveraged 25 years of glazing experience when he struck out on his own. "I wish I would have done it 20 years ago," he says when asked whether starting Greenwich Glass was a smart decision. "We have a good group of talent here and expect quality work on any projects big or small," he adds. A small, agile staff means Greenwich Glass can easily serve clients in a variety of markets and with different building types. Storefront glass and curtain walls are the company's primary areas of expertise, along with associated entrance doors and glazing. Glass replacement, residential and

institutional shower glass, custom mirrors, and service work round out the workload. Greenwich Glass is a member of the Architectural Glass and Metal Association (AGMA) and one of its appointed committee members on the Finishing Trades Institute of the Mid-Atlantic Region's (FTI-MAR) Glazing Advisory Council. The company holds Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and Public Works certifications.

#### **LEADERSHIP**

Burt Dameika worked for 25 years as a general foreman for a leading South Jersey glazing subcontractor. As the street boss, he led all projects in the field, coordinating manpower, materials, and problem resolution. A combination of the economic downturn and leadership changes at the company left Dameika seeking an alternative in 2009. He had a few job interviews but nothing that could offer the same ability to stretch his leadership skills. After his last interview, Dameika stopped on the way home at a car dealership, purchased a van, and committed to starting his own company. He established Greenwich Glass in Mickleton, N.J., keeping one guiding principle – he would never take any customers from his former employer. Instead, he built a new book of business based on quality work and customer service. The last decade proved successful, and the company bought a building and relocated to Paulsboro, N.J. in 2019.

#### **TEAM**

The Greenwich Glass team includes Burt's son Matthew Dameika. Matthew joined LU252 12 years ago and has evolved into a well-rounded mechanic and glazier. He attained the prestigious Architectural Glass and Metal Technician (AGMT) credential last year, affirming his glazing abilities and commitment to safety and quality. Additional teammates Timothy Moore and Eric Sabo keep the shop and field running smoothly.

#### **NOTABLE PROJECTS**

Notable recent projects have included demolition and glass entrance replacements at 14 retail branches for TD Bank, and curtain wall and sunshades for new Chase Bank branches. For the Protestant Home retirement community, Greenwich Glass performed the glazing scope on a new dining facility, including curtain wall, sloped wall, and interior glazing. The company also installed a unique glass art installation for Rowan University at the School of Business.
