## ABOUT THE COMPANY

After 15 years working together, union glaziers and friends Lee Matta and Anthony Jones founded L.A. Glass and Door in 2011. Together, they and their team have 40+ years of glazing experience and pride themselves on impeccable service and quality craftsmanship. Based in Egg Harbor Township outside of Atlantic City, N.J., the company performs roughly \$2 million in work per year. Extensive glass services range from commercial windows and doors to residential showers and tabletops. Despite its small size, L.A. Glass and Door performs complicated and challenging work, including custom railings and rare glass color and pattern combinations. The company's technicians work with leading manufacturers for superior glass and hardware.

## SPECIALTY DIVISION

In 2019, the company started Motion Access, LLP, a specialty division that focuses on automated access and revolving doors. Matta holds American Association of Automatic Door Manufacturers certification for installation and service.

## NOTABLE PROJECTS

Strong relationships with general contractors have brought L.A. Glass and Door to projects around the country, including a recent interior fit-out of a warehouse in Texas.

“We work well with general contractors and have built our business through word of mouth,” explains L.A. Glass and Door Administrative Services and Project Development lead Kerri Garner. “For many GCs, we become their go-to glazier.”

New hotels factor among the company’s most significant work, with two or three major hotel assignments each year. The L.A. Glass and Door scope typically includes storefront glazing, frameless showers, and automated access doors throughout each building. The company has completed hotels in Florida, Connecticut, and Pennsylvania, with its most recent project a new Residence Inn in Reading, Pa., that is currently under construction. In June 2020, L.A. Glass and Door contributed to the Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Atlantic City’s mission to improve accessibility by supplying and installing automatics on multiple pairs of entrance doors.

## COMMUNITY SERVICE

L.A. Glass and Door generously supports its local community. The company provides discounted and sometimes free glazing maintenance services to members of the military and local houses of worship. With the advent of Covid-19 in 2020, the company began offering similar discounts to frontline workers. “We see it as a thank-you and a payback,” Garner explains of the community support. She adds that L.A. Glass and Door and its employees also contribute to annual toy drives and donate gifts to families in need during the holiday season.

## SERVICE AND VALUE

A family-owned company, L.A. Glass and Door emphasizes service and value for commercial and residential customers alike. The company makes a commitment to offering affordable and fair prices, performing accurate service, responding to needs as quickly as possible, and working hard to ensure satisfactory results. Yet L.A. Glass and Door never shies away from a challenge. “We’re versatile,” explains Garner. “Because we’re a small company, we’re very open to traveling and we’re willing to take on complicated projects that others might walk away from.”
